Must work with faculty member who has a faculty appointment at Drexel or one of their clinical sites. Must meet with faculty member to develop project proposal. Need to complete the MSSRF application.	Steps in application process: 1. Construct a project proposal approved by the neurosurgical faculty mentor – should be approximately 1 page with a background detailing the problem and the current gap in the literature, the research question, and the proposed methods to address it. 2. Write personal statement (less than 2,000 characters detailing personal biography and reasons for interest) 3. Complete application 4. Submit all items via email along with your CV to Jody.Leonardo@ahn.org
